Children and adults arriving at the school compound	Pupils, Parents and Staff	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children and parents making their way through the walk-path leading up to the school's entrance to socially distance • Pupils will be directed by adult to the classroom where workshop is being conducted • Both pupils and parents will be encouraged to clean their hands using hand sanitiser or using the nearest toilet on the way in
Unable to trace visitors to report Track and Trace	Unknown numbers of people exposed to Covid-19	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ensure all visitors access the risk assessment in advance of their visit via website • Record contact details • No visitors inside the school building at any point during the Art workshop • Workshop lead and assistant to maintain social distancing
Getting or spreading Coronavirus by not washing hands or not washing them adequately	Pupils and Staff	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Our staff must wash hands upon arrival and exiting the school. • Identify the nearest washing station and toilets for pupils upon arrival

		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All children will be told they must wash their hands at the nearest wash point before workshop can begin. • Should a pupil cough or sneeze; they will be instructed to kindly go to wash their hands immediately.
<p>Catching Corona Virus via the mixing of bubbles / cross contact groups / not social distancing.</p>	<p>Pupils, Parents and Staff</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Our staff will remain socially distanced from all children • Children will be reminded at the beginning of class and throughout the session why it is vital to remain within their own area • All class content / lesson plans have been reviewed and re-written so that all activities can be run at a social distance and do not require any close bodily movement or touching with peers. • All materials and work areas will be sanitised before and after session 1 and before the beginning of session 2 • Pupils will stay in their own separate area apart from each other • Where possible all windows will be left open to increase ventilation

Catching corona virus at dismissal time	Staff and pupils	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Individuals will leave the school site immediately, if they are awaiting collection they will wait outdoors in isolation from others
Sanitisation	Staff and pupils	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Measures will be taken to ensure hands and school equipment, including chairs and tables are sanitised before and after each session• Hand sanitiser and anti - bacterial wipes will be provided to pupils during sessions
